New, only since 2010 officially open for trekking, without a doubt one of the best and (easy) treks in Nepal, the trail has been given a name of '[Indigenous Peoples Trail](#)' (IP Trail) in honor of the six major ethnic settlements in the area. The trekkers are welcomed into the culture and lifestyle of indigenous communities including Sherpa, Newar, Thami, Tamang, Yolmo and Majhis in this lively cultural route. The two major religions in Nepal - Hinduism and Buddhism are ever present in the form of gods and goddesses, temples, stupas, gumbas, monasteries and sacred caves. **Nepal Charity Trek** par excellence with the local people who want to show their culture and share it with others, but also a trek where you have the opportunity to give something back to the community in terms of charity.
